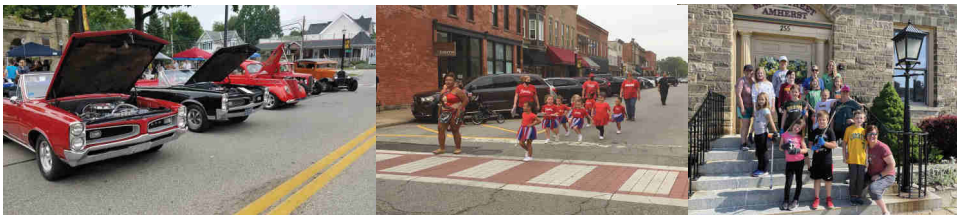

Walkin' on Wednesdays– Stroll the streets of the historic downtown district, after you have dinner at one of the many restaurants, to visit the vendors, shops and car show.

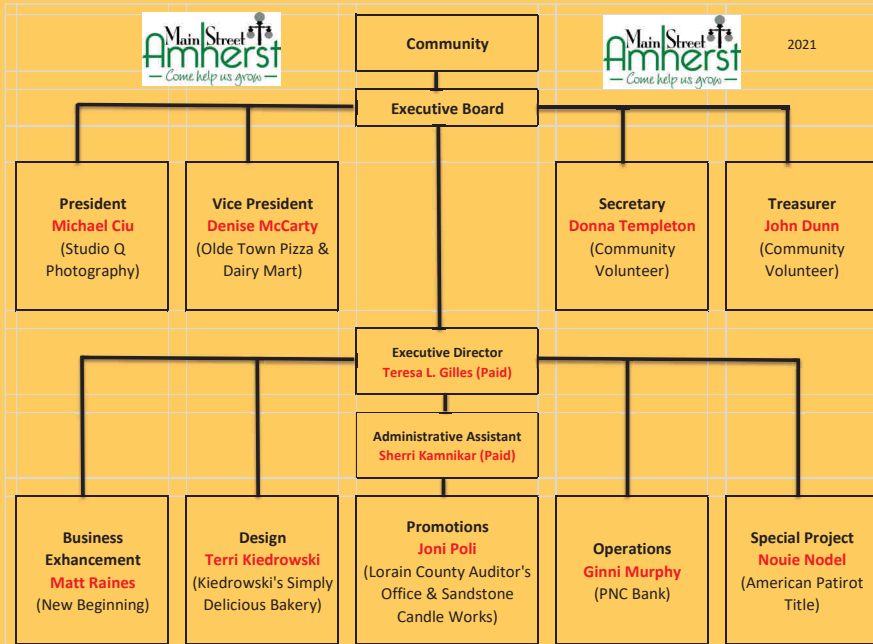
